Our Commitments

• Packaging

Recyclable materials, reduced plastic, minimal waste across all operations.

• Transport

Two EVs added to fleet. Routes optimised to reduce delivery emissions.

• Energy

Investments in lighting and refrigeration efficiency. Natural gas 8,835 kg CO₂-e · Electricity 20,323 kg CO₂-e.

• Waste

Three segregated streams: recycling (14,397 kg), organic (20,815 kg), contaminated (3,473 kg).

• Water

Active conservation. 1,328 kg CO₂-e tracked - targeted for year-on-year reduction per meal.

• Sourcing

Local, seasonal produce prioritised. Meat category identified as priority lever for emission reduction.
